### WHAT MADE YOU CHOOSE TO WORK AT JP?

The chance to work closely with nationally and internationally recognisable clients, right from the beginning of my career, was an opportunity I couldn't pass up. The culture and work environment is also amazing, which doesn't hurt either!

### WHAT DOES YOUR CURRENT ROLE ENCOMPASS?

My current role as a **Manager** in the **Tax & Advisory division** encompasses a broad spectrum of work. Roughly half of my role is compliance-based, including reviewing financial statements and tax returns that are prepared by the junior staff in my team.

The other half is the part I enjoy the most - I do quite a lot of work on the advisory side of things. This can include anything from advising clients on business acquisitions and sales, to providing assistance during negotiations with banks and other lenders to support business expansion, to assisting with long-term business planning and generational estate planning. The constant interaction and building relationships with clients and stakeholders is the most rewarding part of the job for me.

### WHAT PATHWAY DID YOU TAKE TO GET TO YOUR CURRENT ROLE?

I began at JP as a member of their **Trainee Program**, which offers the opportunity to work part-time while completing an accounting-related university degree. I found this to be hugely complimentary to my studies, and upon completing the Trainee Program (and my degree at Monash), I commenced a full-time graduate role.

I learned so much, both practically and technically, from this hands-on experience, which was supported by external training opportunities offered at the firm. After my first year as a grad, I began my CA qualification, and over the last few years, have progressed through various positions to where I am today.
